


At the end of last half term Year 2 Celebrated their theme with a performance to their parents of 'Great Fire of London', led by Mrs Gabbitas and Miss Smale. The children spoke and sang beautifully and we thank parents and carers for joining us. A wonderful way to finish the half term. Well done Year 2.



This week the children have enjoyed listening to the story of Jack and the Beanstalk. As part of our work in Understanding of the World, the children planted a bean. We have talked about what a plant needs to grow well and watched some videos on this too. The children have placed their bean in a bag with some wet cotton wool so they can see the shoots and roots appear and then we will plant them in a pot with some soil. When they have grown a little more, we will be sending them home and over time, you might have some broad beans to enjoy!



Year 4 have been exploring decimals and this week they looked at comparing, ordering and rounding them. They represented their thinking using many different number lines. We created a class one on the playground, used whiteboards to create a human one and even drew them on our desks using whiteboard pen! Year 4 have really enjoyed learning about decimals.



Class 1 have started their unit on fractions this week. They have been folding paper and shading in drawings to represent a half and a quarter. Today we also began finding these fractions of quantities using our knowledge of sharing equally from our division unit.

This week in their Writing sessions, Year 3 have finished their leaflets all about Big Blue Whales. They have been focusing on the use of paragraphs, subheadings, a range of sentence structures and adverbs. Well done Year 3!
