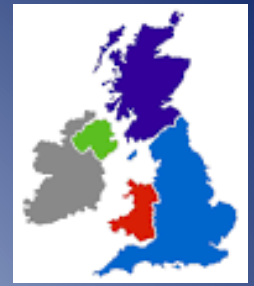




# Our School Vision

# 2018-19 Accomplishments

- Formally joined KMAT 3 September 2018
- Maths No Problem introduced across the school. Teachers from 10 schools have come to observe practice and discuss pedagogical approach.
- Standards in Maths and Writing are very strong and significantly above national at 93% and 90% respectively
- Standards in reading are really good but could be better
- Parent Survey outcomes: 98% or more parents report they are well informed regarding the progress their children make and the next steps to improve their learning
- 4th International Schools Award from the British Council
- Rights Respecting Schools Silver Award from UNICEF
- Egerton recognized formally by the British Council as a school of excellence for global learning and international work – case study to use in their professional development programme
- Mrs Hooper appointed as a British Council Ambassador
- Chartered College of Teaching published a paper 'A Brave Global Curriculum'
- Knutsford Academy joined the Connecting Classrooms through Global Learning Cheshire Cluster led by Mrs Hooper
